Autumn Term

The School Day

Starting Nursery

Our first topic this half term is 'Starting Nursery'. This will then lead onto the topic 'Ourselves'.

In Phonics we will begin tuning into and talking about the sounds we can hear around us. We will also spend time listening to stories and nursery rhymes.

In Maths we will practise our counting through the use of songs and will begin to use touch counting.

Important Days of the Week

Once children are settled into their new routine, we will begin our weekly 'Welly Wednesday'. Children will attend nursery in their own (old) clothes and a pair of wellies. We will then spend the majority of the session outside in our woodland area, exploring, creating and learning outdoors. **A letter and Dojo message will be sent out when we are ready to start our Welly Wednesdays!**

We offer bagels every morning. The children also have the option of having fruit and milk daily.

- A full change of clothes to be kept on pegs (if needed)
- An appropriate coat
