Dear Parents/Carers,

Your feedback comments emphasised how useful and informative you found the meetings to be and the time element allowed you to have more in-depth discussions with your child's teacher about their learning and progress.

Just to update you on a few other matters - Following the elections for school council, held earlier in the term, representatives were elected from Years 2 to 6. We look forward to our school council members taking an active role and voicing their opinions and views which we value hugely. They did a great job introducing themselves to the whole school and outlining what they hoped to achieve.

Since the start of term, we have held a number of assemblies for you to come along to and enjoy seeing your children participate in. Thank you to everyone, the children really work hard collaborating with each other and performing so please do keep coming along as we want to celebrate and showcase what they do. Your very generous donations for the Harvest Assembly were sent to the local food bank and were greatly appreciated.

Curriculum update – Early Years and Key Stage 1 children are now very familiar with Little Wandle Phonics approach to develop their early reading skills. The teaching of letters and sounds using the structured programme was introduced last year and has been successfully implemented in school. Having seen it in use for over twelve months, we feel it provides children with more scope to practice and secure their knowledge from the very start. Our aim of course remains to ensure children are able to read fluently by the time they join Key Stage 2.

Our curriculum also tries to incorporate a wide range of experiences for the children to enhance their learning so trips, visits, visitors in school, matter a great deal. The children also visit the local library regularly now, which helps to support the strong emphasis we place on reading for pleasure.

In Year 6 the children have started to prepare for SATs and we hope they feel that the little bit of extra focus from now, will support them further. We will be sharing additional information about SATs with parents at a workshop planned for later this term.

The next few weeks are going to be very busy as we lead up to the festive period so please do check the events/activities section. Whilst we continue to deliver all aspects of the curriculum and ensure children's learning continues at the same pace, we have incorporated a number of special
