Thank you once again, for your continued support.

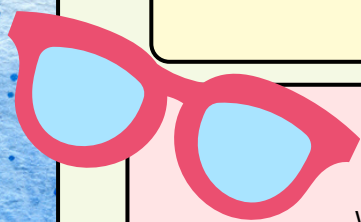
