The School Day

What we are learning-

During our first couple of weeks, we will focus on getting used to our nursery rules and routines as we explore our classroom and build new friendships. Our topic for this half term will be 'All About Me'. We will be reading a range of texts to support our learning and aid discussions about who is in our family, where we live and how we have grown.

Maths: We will be practising our maths skills through counting songs as well as introducing basic counting skills and number recognition.

Phonics: We will introduce the children to our Little Wandle phonics scheme through 'Rhyme Time'

Homework:

Homework will be sent home in book bags on a Friday or set on Class Dojo if it is a practical activity. You are then able to send photos of your child completing their activity or any other learning at home via Dojo for the children to share with their peers during carpet time.

Important Days of the Week

Welly Wednesday:

Children will attend nursery in their own clothes and trainers. They will need to bring with them a pair of wellies. We will then spend the majority of the session outside in our woodland area, exploring, creating and learning outdoors.

Friday:

Please ensure children bring their book bags to Nursery on a Friday, so that we can change books, we cannot give a new book until the previous one is returned.

Reminders

Please ensure that your child brings to school:

- A labelled water bottle everyday
- A full change of clothes to be kept on pegs
- An appropriate coat

Please ensure that your child's clothing and water bottles are clearly **labelled** with their full name as these can get mixed up. We offer bagels every morning.

The children are offered fruit and milk daily. If children wish to bring their own snack, this must only be fruit or vegetables.
