English

Autumn 1 – Corey's Rock

A moving novel incorporating themes of loss and new beginnings, friendship and cultural heritage, against the backdrop of the Orkney Islands.

Autumn 2 – Street Child

A novel based on the life of Jim Jarvis, a young orphan who escapes the workhouse in London in the 1860s and survives brutal treatment.

Reading – Holes by Louis Sachar & The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Rauf

Themed fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts with questions to support the development of comprehension.

Maths

Place Value within 10,000,000 – Learn to read and write numbers to 10,000,000, partition, compare and order numbers, round numbers and work with negative numbers.

Four operations – Use written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, find common factors and multiples, learn about prime, square and cube numbers.

Fractions – Simplify fractions, compare and order fractions, add and subtract fractions including mixed numbers, solve problems involving adding and subtracting fractions.

PE

Orienteering - skills of map reading, team work and problem solving around the school field, forest area and playground.

Handball – skills of passing, throwing, and defence.

Science

Classification of Living Things – Explore the types and characteristics of organisms that belong in each of the five kingdoms of living things (animals, plants, fungi, bacteria and Protista)

Evolution & Inheritance – Explore changes in the inherited traits of organisms through successive generations.
