Increase in School Meals – September 2026

Walsall Council is our dedicated school food provider, their mission has always been to deliver delicious and nutritious meals at affordable prices for all children. However, as we all continue to navigate the ongoing price hikes, we have experienced the ripple effects in our daily operations, including rising food prices and increasing everyday costs. These changes have inevitably impacted the prices we pay for food and the wages we offer to our staff.

Therefore, we wanted to inform you that, in order to mitigate these challenges, we have explored various options, such as changing suppliers and introducing new product lines in our upcoming menu. Despite these efforts, we must adjust our prices to fully address the increases. Consequently, starting from 1st September 2026, we will be implementing a slight price increase of 5p per meal to all PAID meals.

This will result in the cost of a child's meal rising to £2.35 .
