MFL Curriculum Overview 2024 - 2026

At our school, pupils in KS1 begin to speak some French vocabulary and say some basic French greetings. We use the Salut! programme for teaching French which is designed for UK schools and provides support and challenge for pupils. Salut! offers a fun, interactive and visual approach to learning a new language.

The programme is well planned and organised and a programme that covers a range of topics to develop pupil confidence. Lessons introduce new vocabulary, interactive spelling and listening games. Pupils are encouraged to ask questions and answer questions, develop fluency skills and develop their ability to converse with one another. Some lessons have songs incorporated into the lesson planning to further enhance learning experiences and support understanding.

Salut! is designed to be used with all pupils regardless of their ability.
