#### What we are learning-

Our topic for Spring 2 is 'Animals Everywhere'. We will be reading and exploring a range of texts, such as, Dora's Eggs, Dear Zoo and A Rumble in the Jungle. You can help by talking to your child about different animals and where they live.

**Maths:** We will be practising our counting through counting songs, learning about patterns and exploring inset puzzles.

#### Homework:

We will either hand out a paper homework task or set it on Class Dojo if it is a practical activity.
