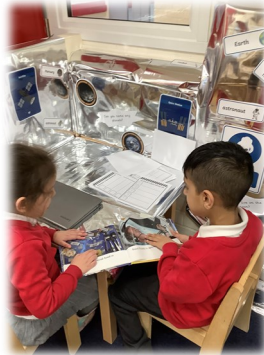


Reception Spring News!
